I write in response to your Freedom of Information Act 2000 (or 'FoIA 2000') request dated **20/11/2020** in which you requested:

"Under FOIA please send me a copy of the ACPO (2008) Manual of Guidance on Keeping the Peace (as endorsed by ACPOS)."

Decision

When a request for information is made under the FoIA 2000, a public authority has a general duty under section 1(1) of the Act to inform an applicant whether the requested information is held. There is then a general obligation to communicate that information to the applicant.

In line with section 1(1) of the FoIA 2000, I can confirm the College **does not hold** the 2008 version of the Manual of Guidance on Keeping the Peace.
