RE: Your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000

I write in response to your Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('FoIA 2000') request, dated 22/10/2021, in which you requested:

"Please provide a list of all reasonable adjustments offered by the College of Policing and any associated information held surrounding each reasonable adjustment.

This will capture if the College of Policing offer pre-recorded interviews as a reasonable adjustment."

Decision

When a request for information is made under FoIA 2000, a public authority has a general duty under section 1(1) of the Act to inform an applicant whether the requested information is held. There is then a general obligation to communicate that information to the applicant.

In line with section 1(1) of the FoIA, I can confirm the College **holds no recorded information** relevant to your request. We do not keep a record of which reasonable adjustments have been offered.

For context, at application stage, we ask candidates if reasonable adjustments are required and try to accommodate these on a case by case basis. We have not been asked to provide pre-recorded interviews as a reasonable adjustment before, however, this may be able to be accommodated if requested.
