I write in response to your Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('FoIA 2000') request, dated 22/03/2022, in which you requested:

"Are you able to provide a break down of the PASS/FAIL on the NPPF Sergeants Examination results released today by Ethnicity, Faith and Gender?"

Decision

When a request for information is made under FoIA 2000, a public authority has a general duty under section 1(1) of the Act to inform an applicant whether the requested information is held. There is then a general obligation to communicate that information to the applicant. In line with section 1(1) of the FoIA, after conducting careful searches, I can confirm the College **holds recorded information** relevant to your request.
