**RE: Your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000**

I write in response to your Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('FoIA 2000') request, dated 17/01/2022, in which you requested:

"I would like to enquire what job positions are within the College of Policing organisation open to applications to persons aged 16 years plus, and persons within the organisation aged 16-18."

**Decision**

When a request for information is made under FoIA 2000, a public authority has a general duty under section 1(1) of the Act to inform an applicant whether the requested information is held. There is then a general obligation to communicate that information to the applicant.

In line with section 1(1) of the FoIA, I can confirm the College **holds no recorded information** relevant to your request.

There are no roles advertised which are only open to those aged 16 – 18. All roles are open to individuals aged 16 and over dependent upon the candidate meeting the eligibility criteria. The eligibility criteria determines that some College of Policing roles are only open to internal staff or wider civil service employees. Other roles are open to all external candidates.

In addition to the eligibility criteria, each role has essential criteria listed on the job description which must be met by the candidate.
