"Please could you provide me with NPPF Inspectors' step-two legal examination subject area breakdown for years 2019, 2018 and 2017?"

Decision

When a request for information is made under FoIA 2000, a public authority has a general duty under section 1(1) of the Act to inform an applicant whether the requested information is held. There is then a general obligation to communicate that information to the applicant. In line with section 1(1) of the FoIA, after conducting careful searches, I can confirm the College **holds some recorded information** relevant to your request.
