**RE: Your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000**

I write in response to your Freedom of Information Act 2000 ('FoIA 2000') request dated **08/03/2021**, in which you requested:

"I Would like a copy of the latest ViSOR standards booklet for my university paper. I have 3.1 and 2.0 but now can't find 3.1 if that's that's the latest copy can you send it as a .pdf, if it's not the latest one could you please send the latest copy plus and copies in between 3.1 and the latest?"

**Decision**

When a request for information is made under the FoIA 2000, a public authority has a general duty under section 1(1) of the Act to inform an applicant whether the requested information is held. There is then a general obligation to communicate that information to the applicant.

In line with section 1(1) of the FoIA 2000, I can confirm the College **does not hold** information relevant to your request.

We recommend you make a request to the Home Office instead.
